
# We've never been here; now, let's get through it

From the perspective of **47 working years**, it's safe to say -we've never been here before.

And look what can happen in aweek. We've gone from **recommended** "social distancing" - perhaps the better phrase is "physical distancing," to be explained below - to **mandated shutdown** of **in-house dining**, and the **closure** of **gyms** and **museums** and **bars** and government office **lobbies**, as America attempts to **'flatten the curve**" of coronavirus infection.

In flattening the curve, of course, weflatten the economy. Southern Arizona hotel rooms are empty when they should be filled. Restaurants are closed. Non-essential retail is quiet, while grocery stores have lines outside, reminiscent of the long gasoline lines some of us experienced during the 1973 oil embargo. This is a rough moment, for everyone.

People are **losing** jobs, some **temporarily**, others for **good**. In the next week, your **Chamber** and its **Foundation** will construct a plan to help**displaced** local workers. Most likely, that aid will come in the form of purchased **gift cards** for groceries and essentials. We'll put **Chamber** and **Foundation** money into it, money earned from serving you. And we'll **ask** for your **help**.



In 1973, after some time, those gasoline lines dwindled. In 2020, grocery store lines will grow smaller, too, and TP will once more be widely available. This too shall pass.

Still, how do we get there? You've beengreat with your suggestions. Here are some ideas to keep business going, with links and information below. Support restaurants with take-out, delivery and gift cards. Shop local merchants who offer online opportunity. Why not buy some plants - it's springtime and beautiful outside, after all - or get your hair done, or your car washed, or make those irrigation system repairs? By all means, be

**physically distant** whenever possible. **Don't** put yourself at great risk. If you are**ill**, please **stay home**. If you are "of an age (my age!)," be **smart** about **what** you do and **where** you go. But let's keep **living**.

And let's protect the social fabric that makes community. Be kind to store clerks and service people, who are at elevated risk. Tip, generously, when you are able. Make a grocery run for aneighbor. Don't hoard. Eat what's in the freezer. Buy gas - it's dropped 20 cents a gallon from last week. Be kind. Be socially immersed. Food banks need volunteers. Give blood. Call your Mom and Dad. Use social media to connect, rather than distract.

Practice physical distance, but social closeness.

We're **closing** the **Chamber** office at **5 p.m. Friday**, and plan to work at home at least until**April 1**. We'll all be available by **e-mail** (next to our pictures, below left), and we'll be**checking** messages. We'll **continue** with our regular **communications** on **Tuesday** and **Friday**, and as things change we'll let you know**right away**.

Please take care. We're grateful for your support. Let's get through this, together.

Tucson Police K9 Unit had one of their K9's became very ill and needed medical attention for months before being cleared for duty. After going back to work, Nova caught a bad guy who, in the process of the arrest, bit the dog causing serious injury. The medical bills, for just this dog alone, were in excess of 15K. This cost depleted the funds earmarked for bite suits. Bite suits are not cheap – between 1500 to 2000 \$\$ each. The ones they have now are well over 12 years old.
